## TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

The Office of Student Activities, in cooperation with Transportation Services, is happy to provide the following transportation options for official student organizations. From time to time, student groups have expressed a need for transportation to and from meetings, matches, or performances outside of the Boston area. In order to ensure that student groups have better options to manage the risks associated with travel, we have negotiated the following agreements at discounted rates.

### 1. Enterprise Rental Car

#### TERMS:

\$54.50 per day

Seven-person minivan or similar vehicle

150 free miles per day included

Includes 500,000 worth of collision and comprehensive insurance, under-25 fee waived, and extra driver surcharge waived

Rental must originate from Massachusetts Avenue or Western Avenue Enterprise locations

Enterprise will accept returns on Sunday at Western Avenue location or returns on Monday at the Massachusetts

Avenue without extra day charge as long as return is done at store opening.

#### REQUIREMENTS:

Must be at least 21 years of age or older.

Minimum two drivers on rental agreement - both drivers must be present at time of rental with valid driver's licenses.

Must present Harvard University I.D. and be an officially recognized student organization of Harvard College.

### 2. Cavalier Coach

#### TERMS:

\$190 for four hours. Extra hours incur additional charge.

14 passenger van

Driver Included.

OR

\$350 for four hours. Extra hours incur additional charge.

55 passenger coach

Driver Included.
